Security: Overnight security will be provided.

Health Requirements: All llamas and alpacas must be free of infectious diseases and its signs. The State of Iowa requires Veterinary Inspection for llamas and alpacas imported into Iowa.

Registration Requirements: Llamas and Alpacas must be registered with the ILR or ARI. See the ALSA Handbook for exact rules. Copies of the Registration Certificates must be sent with the entry form. All participants in ALSA Regional Championship Shows must be a member of ALSA. See also 2010 general info from the ALSA office.

Stalling: Stalls must be reserved in advance. If showing in the Regional **and** LFA Futurity use the Futurity registration form to reserve your stalls. If you are exhibiting in the G.L. Regional **only** use the Regional entry form. A special sponsor has stepped up to assist our YOUTH exhibitors with their stall fee. Only youth animals showing only in the Regional will receive this discount. Stalls have solid floor with rubber mats. You are responsible to provide bedding. In addition to your carpet/mats - hay, straw or card board is allowed to bed animals. Two adult animals per stall allowed. Please be **accurate** in your stall requests. **You must clean your stall(s) upon departure to avoid penalty charge.** Card board bedding can be ordered directly through Steven's Llamatique. 1-800-469-5262.
