*The 2018 Central Regional Championship show has again been invited to be held in partnership with the Oklahoma State Fair Llama Show.*

Entry information for the Oklahoma State Fair can be found at [okstatefair.com](http://okstatefair.com). The listed deadlines are strictly adhered to for fair entries.

Regional entries must be postmarked by August 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018 in order to coordinate stalling and admission onto the grounds. Exhibitors must abide by the rules and regulations of the Oklahoma State Fair, ALSA 22nd edition Handbook and revisions as posted on the ALSA website.

**It is your responsibility to know the rules and regulations!**

**Benefits and Perks:**

- Double ALSA show (OK State Fair and Central Regional) with the potential to earn triple points (Regional earning double points) for one set of travel expenses
- Reduced entry fees for Halter, Performance and Youth Classes
- Low stall fee good for both shows
- Free gate admission **ONLY** for Central Regional exhibitors who are **also** entered in the Oklahoma State Fair
- May use credit card to pay for entry fees
- All Grands and Reserve Champion Awards at any Regional Championship will apply toward an ALSA Champion or Elite Award regardless of the division size.

**Facility:** The show will be held at the State Fair Park, home of the Oklahoma State Fair, in Oklahoma City, OK. Please enter through Gate 7 where you will be given instructions upon arrival.

**Arrival for Regionals:** **May arrive any time after 3:00 p.m. on Thurs., Sept 20<sup>th</sup>. Must be in place and checked in by 6:00 pm, Friday, Sept 21<sup>st</sup> for halter classes. Must check in by 6:00 pm Saturday Sept 22<sup>nd</sup> for performance classes.** Health papers must be presented at the entry gate and you will also show your confirmation letter that was sent to you to be able to pick up your gate passes.

**Departure:** May leave anytime at your convenience. *However, you must obtain a release form from the Regional Superintendent at the Oklahoma State Fair before removing animals from the fairgrounds.*

**Show Schedule:** Information Packets will be given at check-in, on times and class order. Times are approximate.

**Friday, Sept 21<sup>st</sup>** 6:00 p.m. Showmanship Classes 2-5, 204

**Saturday, Sept 22<sup>nd</sup>** -- 8:00 a.m. Youth Judging Classes 12-16

About 10:00 a.m., following Youth Judging Classes, Halter Classes H15-H86B (Regional and Fair combined with 2 judges)

**Sunday, Sept 23<sup>rd</sup>** -- 8:00 a.m. Performance Classes P87-P112

**Health Requirements:** All animals must be accompanied by an individual health certificate stating that the animal is free of infectious or contagious disease, issued within 30 days prior to arrival.

**Registration & Entry Requirements Central Regional:** Llamas and Alpacas must be registered with the ILR or ARI. See the ALSA Handbook for exact rules. Copies of the Registration Certificates, regional entry form and fees must be sent to Mark E. Willy, 3750 Terrace Hills Ct NW, Piedmont OK 73078, not to the Oklahoma State Fair.

**Entry in the Oklahoma State Fair does not automatically enter you in the Central Regional Show or vice versa**

**Admission to grounds Regional Show Participants:**

Exhibitors entering ONLY the Regional Show (and not additionally the Oklahoma State Fair Llama Show) must purchase the necessary admission tickets, either upon arrival at the Gate or through the Oklahoma State Fair ticket office. Advance discount tickets can be purchased online at: <http://www.okstatefair.com/content/hoursadmissionsdiscounts>, or by calling 405.948.6800 starting July 7<sup>th</sup> thru September 12<sup>th</sup>, 2018 only. Check the website for additional information regarding possible secondary purchase locations. **(Admission tickets for Regional Show participants can NOT be purchased through the Livestock or Llama Show offices).** All participants in ALSA Regional Championship Shows must be a current member of ALSA. Be sure and include your animals ALSA number and a copy of your membership card.

**Deadline:** Must be postmarked by Aug. 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018

If paying by credit card, please see the directions on the entry form.  
Refund: No refund will be paid after the deadline for entry.

**Qualifying:** There are no Qualifying Requirements this year for any Regional Championship class. Top 6 winners in each class will be qualified for 2018 ALSA Grand National Show of Champions.

**Points:** Points given for regional championship shows will be doubled.

**Animal Age:** Base date for determining age is September 21st, 2018.

**Halter Classes:** Each Llama/Alpaca must be entered in its appropriate age and wool division at the time of the Regional Championship Show. **Alpacas will be SHORN for Halter Alpaca Classes**

**Performance Divisions:** A Llama/Alpaca may show in one Performance Division (Youth, Masters, Advanced or Novice).

**Stalling:** Stall fee is \$30.00 per stall and is only paid once for both shows. If you are entering the Fair show, send stall fees with the Fair entries. If you are only entering the Regional show, stall fees must be paid at check in or you will not be allowed to show. Stall checks for regional only exhibitors will be made out to the OK. State Fair. Stalls will be pre-assigned. Stalls are approximately 9'x9' on hard surface. No bedding is provided. Bedding and feed are available on the grounds at your expense. Please request an accurate number of stalls. Requests for stalling assignments will be honored as much as possible. Tack stalls are also \$30 and should be included in your total stall number request.

**Pictures:** Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion animals from each division must be taken to the backdrop for photographs each day.
