Health Requirements: Health certificates are not required for llamas from Colorado. **All out of state llamas** must be accompanied by a health certificate issued by an accredited veterinarian in the state of origin and indicating that the animals are free from signs of infectious diseases and have been treated for scabies within 21 days prior to entry into Colorado. Any animals showing evidence of infectious, contagious or communicable diseases must be immediately withdrawn from the show and removed from the grounds, along with all animals with which they were trailered or stalled.

Registration Requirements: Llamas and Alpacas must be registered with the International Lama Registry or ARI. See the ALSA Handbook for exact rules. Copies of the Registration Certificates must be sent with the entry form. All participants in ALSA Regional Championship Shows must be a member of ALSA. See also 2018 general info from the ALSA office.

Stalling: BYOP, Bring your own pens and panels. We will have a few paddocks available but would be better if you brought your own.

Water is available for the llamas. We cannot accommodate blowers, but this is a NO GROOM SHOW. The choice whether or not to groom is yours.

Llamas & Alpacas Only: <u>No other animals</u> allowed near the arena or obstacle course area.

Vendor Fee: \$50.00 fee for all vendors.
