ххх, 2023	Per November 9, 2022, BOD meeting minutes and subsequent discussion with the judges' committee, the following changes have been made to the judge certification process. • The requirement for an advanced clinic has been removed from both llama and alpaca judge certification. Additional clinics may be required if warranted by the three apprenticeship

evaluations.

- ALSA will allow certified ILR judges in good standing to become ALSA judges. This approval would be subject to a clean ILR Show Division judges' file, payment of ALSA membership dues, and the approval of both the judges' committee and the BOD. Applications should be made to the ALSA judges' committee chair.
- The annual open book test has been eliminated.
 Items such as handbook changes and discussion of judging situations will be communicated to the judges by the judges' committee chair.

Also, I have received information that the next handbook revision is to be completed by Dec. 31, 2023. As I have not heard from any of the committees other than ones I am on, I am concerned that this is an unrealistic date. All these individual sections have to go through the handbook committee as well as being approved by the BOD. This is a time-consuming process.
