Stalling, Tack Areas & Farm Displays

All stalling will be pre-assigned by the stalling crew. All stalls are 10' X 10' horse stalls. No more than two adult llamas, 3 juvenile llamas or 3 alpacas are permitted in each stall. Stalls for tack may be purchased at the same price-\$50.00 per stall.

THE STALLS MAY NOT BE USED FOR BREEDING.
There is no cooking or heaters allowed in the stalls.

Facility Policy on Dogs:

Dogs on leashes are allowed but there will be no dogs allowed in the arena area.

Bedding

All stall floors are concrete. Stall floorings allowed are mats, pellets, straw and hay. If you want to use shaving, **Bags of shavings can be purchased for \$8 per bag.** No outside shavings are allowed. No cardboard bedding is allowed.

Grooming

There are wash racks.

Water & Electric

Both water and electric are available in the barns. Exhibitors are responsible for bringing their own extension cords.

Halter Classes

Each llama must be entered in its appropriate age and wool division at the time of the ALSA Grand National. On a llama's date of birth, the llama moves up to the older class. All wool divisions will be included in the ALSA Grand National Show. If you showed at

a show where wool divisions were combined (e.g., Light/Medium or Medium/Heavy), you must choose the correct wool division for the ALSA Grand Nationals.

The Alpaca Halter will be conducted as a Level I Show. Please review Part K of the ALSA Handbook for rules relating to Alpaca Halter Classes and contact the Grand National Committee if you have any questions.

For Get of Sire and Produce of Dam, please make your entry in the Dam or Sire's name on your entry form and send a copy of their ILR/AOA Certificate.

Sub Junior

Sub Junior classes are available at the ALSA Grand National Show at no cost to the exhibitors. The classes available are Obstacle and Showmanship.

All forms are available to be printed and must accompany the Shorn Fleece and Finished Products entries.

See the ALSA 21st Edition Handbook, Part O, for entry requirements and procedures for all Fleece Classes.

General Rules:

All Classes:

- All entries must be made in the name of the registered owner(s) as listed on the Registration Form OR have a Permission to Show Form.
- All fiber artists must have an ALSA Number

Walking Fleece:

- Judging begins November 10, 2023 (Friday). Walking Fleece will be judged Friday.
- Exhibitors' scorecards will be available to the exhibitors after the competition.
- There will be no pulling or plucking of Llama fiber. Blunt tipped safety scissors may be used to clip a small sample to attach to the score card as a reference or teaching tool, but only with the handler's express permission. The sample should be the smallest amount possible and taken from an area that will not adversely affect the animal's appearance or damage the prime fleece. An exhibitor's refusal to allow a sample to be clipped shall in no way affect the judge's score.

Shorn Llama Fleece, Alpaca Fleece and Finished Products:

- Judging begins November 10, 2023 (Friday).
- Shorn Full Blanket Fleeces must be presented in a clear plastic bag with entry tag.
- Send to Susan Leslie, 651 Land Ranch Road, Seguin, Tx 78155 to be received prior to October 11, 2022. Hand delivered Fleeces and Finished Products must be at the Fleece Check-In area prior to 9 am Oct 28, 2022 (Friday).
- Shorn fleeces can be mailed to Susan Leslie for delivery to the Gr Nationals

Awards

Ribbons awarded 1st through 6th place in each Fleece and Finished Product Division. Grand and Reserve Grand Ribbons will be presented for each Fleece Division in Walking and Shorn Fleece and Finished Products.
