	8:30am	Youth and Adult Showmanship, Youth Judging, followed by all Llama, Non-Breeder and Alpaca halter classes. Then all the male divisions followed by the female divisions. Produce of dam and get of sire will be followed by High Point Llama of Show and Best of Show Halter. (not an ALSA class).

Health requirements: Health certificates are not required for llamas. However, check for California entry info if you are coming from out of state.

Registration requirements: Llamas and alpacas must be register with the ILR or ARI. See the ALSA Handbook for exact rules. Copies of the registration certificates must be sent in with your entry form. All participants in ALSA Regionals Championship Shows must be a member of ALSA. 2019 western Regional will be held in accordance with the current ALSA Handbook.

You do not have to qualify to enter the Regional show. You do have to be an ALSA member to show.

Grands and reserve grands will count in every division regardless of number of entries. Points earned at Regional shows are double.

General rules for the fairgrounds:

Area "B" west end parking is to be used for camping (tents, motorhomes, trailers) and parking. The concrete by the Exhibit Hall, the barn enclosures, and the grass area around the Barn enclosures is not to be used for camping or parking unless requested in advance and approved by the Ramona Junior Fair Board.

No straw shall be permitted for animal bedding or other ground cover. Exhibitors must clean up after their animals and on Sunday before they leave.

All trash must be cleaned up before you leave the show.

Saturday Night Fun Class

Gambler's Choice – Entry fee \$5.00 per animal. This is a timed obstacle course that does not follow any rules. Do what you can to get your Llama or Alpaca through the course and complete as many obstacles as you can. A percentage of the entry fees will be awarded to the winners. 1st place wins 75% of the pot, 2nd place wins 25% of pot. We will do this in 3 different classes. Adult, Novice and Youth.

You can enter this class at check in.
