A group of teenaged girls helped show llamas from the Nennis' farm. Dressed in jeans with rhinestone belts, the girls looked like they could have been about to put on a country music concert.

"In Hamilton County, we all have sparkly belts," said Lexi Foerder, 14. The girls were competing in five classes. Three were performance classes, one was

showmanship and one was youth judging. During youth judging, the goal was to come as close to the actual judges' decisions as possible. The performance classes involved

obstacle and pack courses and public relations and aim to judge the handler and llama as a team.

Showmanship is simply "you presenting your llama," Lexi said. The girls qualified for the national show by doing well at earlier competitions.

Working with llamas is fun, the girls said, because the animals are sweet.






Prominent businessman, philanthropist Richard Snyder dies at 74



Snyder fell in his home, injured his head and was flown to Morristown (N.J.) Hospital, where he died.

Born in Carlisle, and raised on a nearby dairy farm, Snyder graduated Big Spring High School in 1957 after attending a one-room schoolhouse from kindergarten through eighth grade. He graduated from Pennsylvania State University in 1961.

A certified public accountant, Snyder served in various executive management positions until 1991 when he retired from Philip Morris International where he was executive vice president, Europe-Middle East-Africa.


After his retirement, he maintained his Sutton Place apartment in New York, but lived primarily in Milford, where in 1985 he purchased Foster Hill Farm.

Snyder wanted to keep the property as a working farm but wasn't interested in the usual farm livestock, noting that he had his fill of milking cows when he was a child.

Instead, he became a well-known llama breeder, active in the Pennsylvania Llama and Alpaca Association, serving as its president, and a nationally prominent leader in the llama breeding industry. Many of his herd, which at one time numbered more than 100, are prizewinners; an entire wall of the llama barn at his farm is covered with scores of ribbons and awards from llama competitions.

Each July, Snyder sponsored an Open Barn Day for visitors to walk among the llamas and the horticulture on the 70-acre organic farm
