## TABULATION OF Cart Driving CHAMPIONS GRAND AND RESERVE

### REQUIREMENTS:

1. Llamas must be entered in at least two of the following classes which makes up the Carting Division. The division numbers will be totaled together:
  - A. Cart Driving ( Obstacle)
  - B. Performance Driving
2. The number of points accumulated from each class placing must be determined by the ALSA Point Chart (Below)  
The llama with the highest Point Total is the Champion and the llama with the second highest Point Total is the Reserve Champion.
3. Ties must be broken by taking the llama placing highest in the Carting or Obstacle Class.
4. There must be 6 entries in the Carting Division for Carting Champion to be credited in the ALSA Award System. Under 6 , Named Grand and Reserves qualify for the ALSA National and Regional Competitions.

Take the number of entries shown in the class and follow over to the column under the placing in the class and you will find the number of points that the animal receives for that class. For example: If there were five entries shown and the animal finishes third in the class, then the animal would receive one point on the ALSA Point Chart.

Animals numbering over 47 to (calculate + 7 ) add 1 placement to 11th place and so on.
