TABULATION OF Junior Youth CHAMPIONS GRAND AND RESERVE

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Youth must be entered in the all three of the following classes using the same animal;
 - A. Junior Obstacle
 - B. Junior Pack
 - C. Junior Public Relations
2. The number of points accumulated from each class placing must be determined by the ALSA Point Chart (Below)
3. The youth with the highest point total is Grand Champion and the youth with the second highest is Reserve Champion.
4. There must be 8 entries in the Obstacle Division for Junior Youth Champion to be credited in the ALSA Award System.
Under 8 , Named Grand and Reserves qualify for the ALSA National and Regional Competitions.
5. Ties occurring in the highest point total must be broken by taking the Youth placing highest in Junior Obstacle to be Champion with the second highest score in Junior Obstacle going to the Junior Youth Reserve Champion

Take the number of entries shown in the class and follow over to the column under the placing in the class and you will find the number of points that the youth receives for that class. For example: *If there were six entries shown and the youth finishes third in the class, then the youth would receive one point on the ALSA Point Chart.*
