Administrative Manager Report, September 2011

Here is the answer to some questions presented to the ALSA Office.

Q.Why has the President and Treasurer not received monthly copies of data base backup.

A. Monthly copies are obsolete, two years ago we set up an online backup service that creates DAILY Backups. President, Treasurer and Current Treasurer have been given those codes and can access the database as well as Quick Book backup as often as they like.

Q.Where is signed copy of Office Contract.

- A. I have a signed copy of contract extension for 2011, dated Feb 10, 2010. I do not have a copy of the actual contract for 2010. Ken may have that.
- Q.Why has Youth Top 10 not been printed and published on the website for 2011.
 - A. The Top Ten Youth covers many categories. One point can make a difference in placements or even to get the youth on the top ten lists. The show that has the most

ALSA Youth has not reported the correct points for the youth, 2 years in a row. This issue cannot be remedied as the judge cards did not place the last youth in each class over 8. Additionally we have a show that has refused to send in results and shows that often do not get their results in till after the end of the year. To issue top ten without having accurate results to work with would be cheating youth of placements. I have asked the board and asked the youth committee to come up with a way to award youth that would be fair. This way is not.

Q. Was check deposited for Protest Fees?

A. Treasure can look in Quick Books for answers to deposit and check questions. Check for \$250. Was deposited on 6/24. Check #107.

Q. Does Alan do entries in Database?

A. Alan works with the .net part of the website and helps with software issues. My staff or myself do all data entry.

Q. When are checks issued for Office?

A. At the first of each month. Checks have to cover all utilities other than phone/fax/internet lines as well as rent for office space, storage, all equipment, employees, business liability insurance, employee insurances, social security, and local employment fees, computer and equipment upgrades and maintenance. The ALSA Office uses 4 rooms and is networked with 4 computers, 2 printers one fax. One room is designated for data entry and contains the QuickBooks program that is accessible remotely by the Treasurer. One room holds files, the file server, fax and printer where the membership cards and certificates are printed. One is used room for storage. Cheryl's office has tables set up for large mailings and also has a lap top computer.. Which can be used in power outage. The Office Contract covers all these expenses.

In response to the above question concerning the Top Ten Youth:

Cheryl will post the Top Ten Youth for 2010 with a disclaimer *Any discrepancy in the placement of the Top 10 may be the result from the information provided by the individual show superintendents*

The BOD has given Cheryl the approval to send an email blast concerning the qualifications to attend the Grand National Show. As usual, the email blast will have to have BOD approval as to wording, etc.

September Treasurer Report

- 1) Membership Income is down 3.9% from this time last year.
- 2) ALSA Show Fee Income is down 26.3% from this time last year. (This could be from a combination of the retirement of several "show" farms, members showing in an alternative show association and the economic situation of our members.
- 3) Total Expenses are down 45.8% from this time last year. The expenses are down to no Regional Premiums and some Regions opting for a National Qualifier instead of a Regional Championship Show (no ribbons, no premiums, judge expenses, etc), to name a few.
- 4) There is a total net loss of \$5,487.
- To date, we have not received any sponsorship money for the 2011 Grand Nationals. We will need to look at different areas where expenses may be reduced.
