LEVEL II ALSA SHOW

ENTRY DEADLINE: April 18, 2009

NEW THIS YEAR! Miniature Llama Classes and a non-ALSA fleece class.

Entries must be postmarked no later than April 18, 2009!

- Required entry fees, stall fees, and copies of ILR registration certificates **MUST** accompany entry form.
- This is an **ALSA Sanctioned Show**. All rules and guidelines for the show will be in accordance with the Current Edition ALSA Handbook.

• **REMEMBER!!!!**

ALL llamas entered in approved classes, with the exception of youth classes must be registered or have passed screening with ILR or CLRC. This also applies to Juveniles and Miniature llamas. If non-breeders are not registered and wish to be in the ALSA award system and wish to show in halter, they must show in the Adult non-breeder halter class.

Non-breeder llamas must be accompanied by a registration or veterinarian certificate verifying the animal is a gelding, vasectomized, or a spayed or non-productive female.

- Registration papers (photocopies) **MUST** be sent with the entry form to Show Management with verification of name and age. Failure to meet this requirement prohibits entry in the show.
- All exhibitors must be a current 2009 member of ALSA or pay a \$30.00 non-member fee per show for a total of \$60.00. Members must either be in the 2009 ALSA List or send a copy of their 2009 ALSA membership card with their entry form.
- Show animals will be allowed into the Barn areas after 8 A.M. Friday and must be in place by 12 P.M. Saturday.
- Release of animals will be after the show on Sunday.
- The bedding approved for use in stalls will be paper, straw, hay, carpet, or mats. Straw and hay **will be available for sale at fairgrounds.**
- Both shows will run concurrently (both judges in the ring at the same time) and separate placements will be made.
- Animals must be washed in designated wash racks only.
- **Please make sure that manure and bedding are disposed of in the manure pits. The show will be charged \$25.00 per can if any is dumped into trash receptacle!**
- Camping facilities are available. Please contact Missouri State Fairgrounds.
- Vendor spaces are also available. Contact Mary Beeson.
- Only Superintendent will assign stalls and location in barns.
- **Missouri Requirements:** "Camels, llamas, alpacas and others of that group must be identified by tattoo, microchip, ear tag or other approved device and be listed individually on a certificate of veterinarian inspection". There are no other health requirements.
- **No changes in wool classes after April 18, 2009 except by Judges.**
- If entering after April 18, 2009 late entry fees of \$80.00 per class must be paid.
- Get or Produce entries may be added after exhibitor arrival at the show on Friday. Offspring must be entered in show. Registration papers for Dam or Sire must be submitted if not entered in the show.
- Exhibitor's Meeting will be at 8:00 a.m. Sunday morning. Show will start at 8:30 a.m.
- Premiums will be given for the first three placings and ribbons through fourth place. Grand and Reserve Champions will receive special awards.
- Show management has determined that "**exhibitors 8 years through 12 years of age not show intact males over 24 months of age**"
