**NEW FOR 2008: SHORN FLEECE IN ADDITION TO WALKING FIBER**

Shorn fleece will be judged Saturday morning and Walking Fiber Saturday afternoon. This is an opportunity to have your llama's fleece evaluated for the price of a class entry. If you can't have your fleece to the show by Saturday morning, you may mail-in fleece until May 5th. An additional charge of \$10 should be included if you need the fleece to be mailed back to you.

**AWARDS:**

Ribbons will be awarded to sixth place in each class. Ribbons and/or Prizes will be awarded to Grand and Reserve Champions in halter and fleece classes, Open Performance Champion, and Youth Performance Champion. You must compete in three classes to qualify for Performance Champion. (Youth must compete in Youth Obstacle, Youth Public Relations and Youth Pack. The same animal must be used in all classes unless the animal is less than 18 months old. In that situation only, the Youth may use a second animal in Youth Pack)

A llama can be entered either in Youth or Non-Youth(Open) classes, but not in both. A llama may not be entered in any class more than once. Youth may compete in Open Performance and Youth Performance if using a different llama for each division.

Youth may exhibit only one entry per youth class. Entry Fee's for youth classes only will be at \$6.00. Sub Jr. Classes will be Free.

Minimum age for a handler in any class is eight years old. Youth twelve years and under are not permitted to show intact adult (24 months & older) male llamas. All youth ages are determined as of January 1st except for eight-year-olds, who are considered to be eight as of their birthday.

All llamas 5 months and older entered in approved classes, with the exception of Youth Classes must be registered or have passed screening with the International Lama Registry (ILR) or the Canadian Livestock Record Corporation (CLRC). Non-breeder llamas do not have to be registered or have passed screening with the ILR or CLRC. If Non-breeders are not registered and wish to be in ALSA Award System and wish to show in halter, they must show in the adult non-breeder halter class.

Copies of registration papers must be sent with entry forms for verification of name and age.

All llamas must be entered in the exact name and registration number as shown on the registration certificate.

**HEALTH REQUIREMENTS:**

All llamas must be de-wormed within 7 days and free of infectious diseases and it's signs. Show management has the right to ask any animal showing signs of ill health or behavioral problems to leave the premises. The State of Minnesota does not require Health Certificates.

**VETERENARIAN ON CALL:** There will be a veterenarian on call Friday through Sunday during the show.

**ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE:**

Arrivals may begin after 3:00 on Friday May 16th. Lamas may leave anytime after they have completed showing. Show animals must be in place and checked in by 8:00 am on the day they are to be shown.

**STALLING:**

**Exhibitors will be responsible for their own bedding and must clean their stalls prior to departure.**

Common tack areas will be provided. Banners may be displayed at stalls.

You may bring your own metal panels or rent stalls. Stall size will be 9' x 9'.

We will allow 2 animals per stall; 3 per stall if under 1 year old. No animals will be allowed to be stalled in trailers.

We will attempt to honor your request regarding location of stalls or your request to be near another exhibitor however we cannot guarantee that we will be able to implement your request.

**ENTRY CHANGES**

Any entry change ( e.g. adding a class or substituting an animal) after arrivals at the show will be charged \$10.00 per change, in addition to any class fee. Substitute animals must qualify to show in the halter or performance class of the original animal. There will be a \$10.00 fee to move animals registered in the wrong class to correct the class after the entry deadline.

**ADVERTISING:**

The show program will offer business card ads for \$10.00. The card must be enclosed with your entries to be included in the program. Half-page ads for \$25.00 and full-page ads for \$40.00 are available.

Class sponsorship is \$50.00 per class and includes a business card ad, your name featured above the class. and promotional announcements during the show.

**VENDOR SPACE:**

Vendor space is available and encouraged. Vendor space is 9' x 9'. Fee is \$50.00 per space and includes a free business card ad. Please contact Ron Pottebaum @ 715-426-5579 or email lazyacresllamas@msn.com.

**GENERAL INFORMATION:**

Entry Fee's for Youth Classes will be \$6.00 per class. This includes class # 4,5,6,8,9,10,12,13,14,15,16,17,34,35,36.

Security will be provided.

Wash Racks are available.

No animals under 5 months of age may be shown.

Nursing mothers may not be accompanied in the ring by their babies.

Llamas may not be moved from one class to another after halter judging has begun, except at the judges discretion.

Sub Junior classes are non-ALSA approved. Parent or guardian must be present at ringside for Sub Junior entrants. Sub Jr. entry fee is FREE. This includes classes # 2 and 32.

Pack Classes; Llamas between 5-36 months will carry no weight. Llamas over 37months must carry a pack system with a total weight of 40 lbs with 2 cinches. It is also required to have removable panniers.

Classes may be combined if there are fewer than three entries per class.

A food vendor will be available on the grounds

**Medium Wool:** Moderate to long body wool,minimal to moderate neck wool, smooth to moderate leg wool.

**Heavy Wool:** Abundant body and neck wool with minimal to abundant leg wool.

**The judge may move a llama to a different wool division.**
